## **Team Showjumping**

**Championship Arena      Start 10.00am**

### **Class 1: 12yrs & Under Team Showjumping**

Open to Riders 12yrs & under, Ponies 148cms & under      Fences approx 2'3" in the first round  
Rider/Pony combinations in this class will not be allowed to compete in Class 4  
Entry Fee: £40.00 per team

### **Class 2: 16yrs & Under Team Showjumping**

Open to Riders 16yrs & under, Horses or Ponies      Fences approx 2'6" in the first round  
Entry Fee: £40.00 per team

Not before 1.30pm

### **Class 3: Midland Novice Team Championships**

Open to Riders any age, Horses or Ponies      Fences approx 2'6" - 2.9" in the first round  
Entry Fee: £40.00 per team

### **Class 4. Midland Open Team Championships**

Open to Riders any age, Horses or Ponies      Fences approx 3'0" in the first round  
Entry Fee: £40.00 per team

### **General Rules**

1. All ages taken from 1st January 2012
2. All teams to consist of 3 or 4 riders, the worst score in each round will be dropped, however where there are only 3 riders in the team, then all scores will count
3. Classes 1, 2 & 3 will be one round and then a jump off
4. Class 4 will be two rounds and then a jump off
5. Any rider who is eliminated in the first round may jump the next round provided their team has qualified for the next round
6. All teams in Classes 1, 2 & 3 which are in equal first place after the first round will then jump off to decide the winner, these times will also be used for the Individual Awards
7. All teams in Class 4 which are in equal first place after the 2nd round will then jump off to decide the winner, these times will also be used for the Individual Awards
8. Placings not decided in the jump off will be decided by the faults and time taken in the preliminary round
9. In the 2nd round of Class 4 and in all jumps off, competitors will jump in order, ie; all 1st riders go first, 2nd riders 2nd, 3rd riders 3rd etc
10. Riders who have jumped clear but their team have not qualified for the jump off, will at the end of the jump off then compete for the Individual Awards
11. The Judges decision is final
12. Riders must be correctly dressed and mounted for the awards presentation
13. Entries for Teams close Wednesday 30th May 2012 - We do not need Team members names

until the monday morning, but we must have them before the relevant team competition starts

### **Team Dressage**

**Netley Arena**

**Start 10.00am**

#### **Class 5: Novice Team Dressage**

Restricted to Riders and Horse or Pony Combinations that have not been placed in the first 6 at the Midarc National Championships

Open to all Riders, Horses or Ponies

Prelim Tests - Prelim 4 & 12

Entry Fee: £40.00 per team

Not before 1.30pm

#### **Class 6: Open Team Dressage**

Open to all Rider, Horses or Ponies

Tests - Prelim 18 & Novice 30

Entry Fee: £40.00 per team

### **General Rules**

1. All teams to consist of 3 or 4 riders, the worst score in each round will be dropped, however where there are only 3 riders in the team, then all scores will count
2. Each Rider in each team will perform both tests
3. The scores from the best 3 riders in each test will be added together, and the team with the highest score will be declared the winner. In the event of a tie, then the countback system will be used for the 3rd Rider of each team to find the winner
4. The Judges decision is final
5. Riders must be correctly dressed and mounted for the awards presentation
6. Entries for Teams close Wednesday 30th May 2012, Team names required at this stage
7. Times available on the web site from Friday 1st June at around 1pm or ring 01902 896607 between 2pm & 4pm
8. Each Class is limited to a maximum of 10 teams per class

### **Important - Notes for Showjumping & Dressage Teams**

Teams may be made up of 3 or 4 riders (4 is best of course), they can be a group of friends, a riding club, livery yard, school, riding school or pony club

No rider can ride more than one pony or horse in the same team

Riders are allowed to compete in more than one team but on different ponies or horses

There will be Midarc trophies for the winning teams, and rosettes to 6th place  
Individual Trophies and also rosettes to 6th place

Prizes in kind to all winners
