No Child under the age of 3 years will be allowed to compete except for Lead Rein Turnout
8. Pony and Horse Measurements  
Ponies are 148cms & Under, except where the class restrictions differ, and may not compete in any Horse Showjumping Competition. Horses are over 148cms.
