#### **Rules for Open and Restricted Sections**

##### **WALK & TROT**

At the Winter Championships any horse and rider combination that has not achieved 65% 2 times at Walk and Trot level before 1<sup>st</sup> September 2011 may ride in the restricted section. Any horse and rider combination that has scored over 65% 2 times before 1<sup>st</sup> September 2011 must then move on to the next level. Eg, If combination has scored over 65% 2 times in **Restricted** Walk and Trot section must move onto **Open** walk and trot section.

##### **PRELIMINARY TESTS**

Any horse that has BD or BE points or is registered may only compete in the open section.

Any horse and rider combination that has not achieved 65% 2 times at preliminary level before 1<sup>st</sup> September 2011 may ride in the restricted section. Any horse and rider combination that has scored over 65% 2 times before 1<sup>st</sup> September 2011 must then move on to the next level. Eg, If combination has scored over 65% 2 times in **Restricted** Preliminary section must move onto **Open** preliminary section and so on.

##### **NOVICE TESTS**

Any horse that has BD or BE points or is registered may only compete in the open section.

Any horse and rider combination that has not achieved 65% 2 times at Novice level before 1<sup>st</sup> September 2011 may ride in the restricted section. Any horse and rider combination that has scored over 65% 2 times before 1<sup>st</sup> September 2011 must then move on to the next level. Eg, if combination has scored over 65% 2 times in **Restricted** Novice section they must move onto **Open** Novice section and so on.

**The competition is reliant on competitor's honesty when entering classes. Any discovery of dishonesty will result in immediate elimination**

**Callers are allowed and will not be penalised, otherwise the rules of British Dressage will be used throughout**

### **RIDER NUMBERS**

As in previous years, these will be available to be collected from the Secretary on the day. If you would like yours sooner, then please send a large Stamped Addressed Envelope ( 220mm x 110mm minimum size) and this will be sent to you upon receipt of your entries.

### **COMPETITOR NOTES**

#### **Receipt of Entry's & Entry Fees**

As we all know the Royal Mail Service is not totally reliable, and as they have told us, putting a stamp on an envelope is no guarantee that they will deliver it. So, please, do not assume that we have received your entry, we recommend that you let us have a large stamped addressed envelope. This way if you have not received your Championship Number back within 10 working days, you can safely assume that we have not received it, and we would advise that you contact us as soon as possible on 01902 896607 (Mon – Fri 10.00am – 5.00pm).

All entries received will also be acknowledged on the web site, please check your rider number to see if we have ticked the entries received box.

For 2012 we are again offering competitors the opportunity to pay by internet banking or Pay Pal, and you will then have the knowledge that we will receive payment within three working days. Please see further details with the entry form
