## Midarc UK Ridden Winter Showing Championships

Judge:

Arena A - Start 9.30am prompt

- Class 1. Senior Novice Rider Championship** - Open to Riders 17yrs & over that have not won 3 1sts in any Senior Rider Classes up to 1st September 2011. Horses & Ponies must be ridden in a snaffle for all Novice Competitions
- Class 2. Senior Rider Championship** - Open to Riders 17yrs & over
- Class 3. Novice Riding Horse Championship** - Open to Riders 13yrs & over, horses over 14.2hh not to have won 3 1sts in any Riding Horse Classes up to 1st September 2011
- Class 4. Riding Horse Championship** - Open to Riders 13yrs & over, Horses over 14.2hh
- Class 5. Ridden Hunter Championship** - Open to Riders 13yrs & over, Horses over 14.2hh
- Class 6. Ridden Large Mountain & Moorland Championship**
- Class 7. Ridden Show Cob Championship** - Open to Show, shown hogged and trimmed
- Class 8. Ridden Traditional Cob Championship** Open to Traditional Cobs, shown in natural state

*Lunch will be taken after Class 8*

- Class 9. Riding Club/Horse or Pony Club & Utility Type Championship**
- Class 10. Coloured and Spotted Horse Championship** - Open to riders 13yrs & over, horses over 14.2hh
- Class 11. Ridden Veteran Horse Championship** - Open to riders 13yrs & over, horses over 14.2hh
- Class 12. Coloured Traditional Championship** - Open to Traditional Coloured Horses, Open to riders 13yrs & over, horses over 14.2hh in natural state
- Class 13. Equitation Championship** - Judged on Suitability, manners and ridden show, Open to riders 13yrs & over, horses over 14.2hh

*After Class 13, the first two from Classes 1 - 13 will come forward for the 2011 / 2012*

*Midarc UK Winter Championships Senior Champion (Highest two placed in 9 for Pony Type will go forward to the Junior Section Championship in Arena B)*

Judge:

Arena B - Start 9.30am prompt

- Class 14. Best Lead Rein Rider Championship** - Riders 8yrs & under, ponies 12.2hh & under, Lead rein to be attached to cavesson noseband
- Class 15. Novice Junior Rider Championship** - Open to Riders 16yrs & under that have not won 3 1sts in any Junior Rider Classes up to 1st September 2011. Ponies must be ridden in a snaffle for all Novice Competitions
- Class 16. Junior Rider Championship** - Riders 16yrs & under, ponies 14.2hh & under
- Class 17. Tiny Tots Best Rider Championship** - Open to riders 10yrs & under, Ponies 13.2hh & under, Lead Rein Riders are allowed to compete in this class but off the lead rein
- Class 18. Lead Rein Pony Championship** - Riders 8yrs & under, ponies 12.2hh & under, Lead rein to be attached to cavesson noseband
- Class 19. Best First Ridden Championship** - Riders 12yrs & under, Ponies 13.2hh & under to be ridden in a snaffle. Lead Rein riders are allowed to compete in this class but off the lead rein
- Class 20. Novice Riding Pony Championship** - Open to Riders 16yrs & under, ponies 14.2hh & under and not to have won 3 1sts in any Riding Pony Classes up to 1st September 2011

*Lunch will be taken after Class 20*

- Class 21. Best Lead Rein Mountain & Moorland Championship** - Riders 8yrs & under, ponies 12.2hh & under, Lead rein to be attached to cavesson noseband
- Class 22. Best Riding Pony Championship** - Riders 16yrs & under, ponies 14.2hh & under
- Class 23. Coloured Pony Championship** - Ponies 14.2hh & under,
- Class 24. Lead Rein Equitation Championship** - Judges on Suitability, manners and ridden show, Riders 8yrs & under, ponies 12.2hh & under, Lead rein to be attached to cavesson noseband
- Class 25. Veteran Pony Championship** - Ponies 14.2hh & under
- Class 26. Ridden Small Mountain & Moorland Championship**
- Class 27. Equitation Championship** - Judges on Suitability, manners and ridden show, Open to riders 16yrs & under, Ponies 14.2hh & under

In Classes where Adults are allowed to ride ponies the two highest placed Adult Riders will go forward to the Senior Championship in Ring A

After Class 27, the first two placed in Classes 14, 18, 21, 24 will go forward to be judged for the 2011/2012 Midarc UK Winter Lead Rein Champion

Following this, the first two placed in Classes 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 22, 23, 25, 27 will go forward to be judged for the 2011 /2012 Midarc Winter Junior Ridden Champion

At the end of the day the first two placed from each Championship in all arenas will be judged for the Midarc UK 2011/ 2012 Winter Showing Champion

#### **Receipt of Entry's & Entry Fees**

As we all know the Royal Mail Service is not totally reliable, and as they have told us, putting a stamp on an envelope is no guarantee that they will deliver it. So, please, do not assume that we have received your entry, we recommend that you let us have a large stamped addressed envelope. This way if you have not received your Championship Number back within 10 working days, you can safely assume that we have not received it, and we would advise that you contact us as soon as possible on 01902 896607 (Mon – Fri 10.00am – 5.00pm).

All entries received will also be acknowledged on the web site, please check your rider number to see if we have ticked the entries received box.
