Welcome to the first newsletter for CashJumping

I hope you enjoy reading the contents and encourage you all to send in comments, articles and pictures for future issues.

When I first thought of the concept of CashJumping only a few short weeks ago and discussed it with Bryan neither one of us envisaged that it would be so successful so quickly.

We were of course aware of the spiralling costs of diesel, fees ,etc for the affiliated riders and the growing unrest amongst a number of affiliated riders that perceived their association to be unresponsive and elitist.

The difficulty was that there was no real viable alternative. Affiliated riders perceived that unaffiliated competitions were poorly run with inferior officials and equipment.

Unaffiliated riders were quite often apprehensive to bridge the gap between unaffiliated competitions and affiliated ones.

CashJumping was designed to bridge that gap and make good quality competition open and affordable to all. Show centres must meet minimum quality standards and all officials have to be approved by us. This seems to be working affiliated riders are attending the shows and the unaffiliated people are discovering that they can compete in the same classes and have the benefit of winning cash!

We recognised that to be successful we would need to maintain a record of the horses achievements which is essential when looking to sell or buy a horse. Currently all prize money won is recorded however we will shortly be recording every competition entered to give a full and accurate record of a horses achievements.

We also recognised that we would need to drop entry fees and improve prize money without making it harder for show centres to maintain their income levels.

By introducing the concept of 50% of entry fees going in to a prize fund shared amongst the top 5 riders in the class in accordance to the pre determined prize grids we were able to achieve just that and take out the risk that show centres had of having to pay out prize money even where the number of entries meant the class was run at a loss.

It also resulted in more prize money being available for the competitors where the classes were larger and accordingly each competitor had a vested interest to encourage their friends to come along to the show and compete too.

The classes start at 60cm for seniors and juniors and go up to 1.30 for juniors and 1.40 for seniors. The three stages of competition are designed to ensure that "pot hunters" are soon having to move up the grades not necessarily having to jump higher but being prevented from competing against people who have less winnings.

Accordingly a combination who have won £500 jumping in 60 cms classes can continue to jump that height but have to enter classes where the winnings limit is higher i.e Stage 2 or 3 classes.

Early signs are extremely encouraging, show centres report packed classes and riders feedback has been very encouraging.

As I write this we are working on the National Championship Final which is scheduled to take place this year at Netley Hall on the 19th, 20th, 21st September and I am currently in discussions with TV producers and broadcasters to get the finals on the box and full details will be out shortly. In future years the finals will either move a round the country to other CashJumping centres or will go to a national venue like the NEC.

CashJumping will no doubt evolve as the weeks and months go by but one thing looks certain and that is, its here to stay and I hope that you all enjoy yourselves and look forward to meeting you all in September!
