7. Lead Rein Riders- Lead Rein Riders may only compete in Lead Rein, First Ridden & Tiny Tots Best Rider Classes.  
No Child under the age of 3 years will be allowed to compete except for Lead Rein Turnout Pony and Horse Measurements
8. Ponies are 148cms & Under, except where the class restrictions differ, and may not compete in any Horse Showjumping Competition. Horses are over 148cms.
