- The show will be run under BRC/PC rules.
- Riding hats, to the current BSI standard, must be worn at all times when mounted.
- Please follow the instructions of stewards and committee.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead.
- No cantering between the rings.
- Please assist us in leaving the show ground clean & tidy. DO NOT muck out horseboxes and trailers. Please take your muck away with you and use the litter bins provided - cattle graze this land.
- Objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with £10 deposit within half an hour of any incident. Deposit will be forfeited if objection is not upheld.
- W&DRC, Croome PC and the land owners accept no responsibility for loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or possession.
- The organisers reserve the right to ask anyone to leave the showground.
- Every care has been taken to ensure the health and safety of all those attending this show. Please make every effort to see that everyone has an enjoyable day.
- No horse/pony may enter more than three classes overall in rings 4 & 5. In ring 4, combinations in classes 34 and/or 35 may only enter class 36 in ring 4 as well.
- Team showjumping is pre-entry only as times will be given. A waiting list will be kept in case of withdrawals. Please ensure you include contact details with entries.
- Combinations entering novice classes in Ring 3 must not have been placed 1st in a Working Hunter class prior to June 20th 2009.

RING 1 - SHOWING

9am start. £8 per class. W&DRC/CHPC members £7

Class 1 Lead rein pony - Mare or gelding, 4 years and over, not exceeding 128cm/12h2.

Riders not to have attained their 7th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Snaffle bridles only with lead rein attached to noseband.

Class 2 Riding Pony - Mare or gelding, 4 years and over, not exceeding 148cm/14h2.

Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Class 3 Hunter Pony - Mare or gelding 4 years and over not exceeding 153cm/15hh rider any age

Class 4 Pony club pony, to be ridden in a snaffle and small jump to be included or gelding, 4 years and over, not exceeding 148cm/14h2. Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year

Class 5 Junior best rider Riders not to have attained their 17th birthday before 1st January in the current year.

Class 6 Championship

In hand Classes not to start before 12pm

Class 7 Mountain and Moorland small & large breeds. Open to registered and unregistered ponies to be shown in a natural state. Class split if entries warrant.

Class 8 Youngsters, all types and breeds, 3 years and under

Class 9 Veteran (15 yrs & over) Special rosette to best over 20.

Class 10 Arabs full and part breeds

Class 11 Coloured, spotted, duns and palominos

Class 12 Best Condition 4 years and over

* Competitors jump one complete course, the latter part of which is higher and timed. Competitors jump the entire course, it does not matter where faults (if any) are scored. Scores are worked out on the basis of overall jumping penalties and fastest timed section.
